- Learning Agreement to be sent to the Academic coordinator:

It will be sent by June (Annual and First semester) or by November (Second semester) following the instructions: <u>INFO 10. LEARNING AGREEMENT</u> Lessons **timetables** cannot overlap and no more than two academic years/level should be mixed up (exceptions to be discussed with the academic coordinator may apply).

It is not possible to take only part of a subject, even when this one has two different ones. The student will have to take the whole of it.

A copy of the automatic-reply email got when nominated must also be sent to the academic coordinator.

 Nursing students coming to this Faculty: Will start their practicum only if they have previously done the following prior arrival at UEx:

Prove of updated vaccination/inmunization schedule (recent and complete serology from your home country (with hepatitis B and post-vac antibodies Hepatitis B and VIH. Tethanus-diphteria. Flu vaccination is highly recommended when appropriate.

This should be sent by email before coming here, as well as the learning agreement and copy of the acceptance email (auto-reply) as requested above.

The UEx might ask the student to be evaluated by a primary attention doctor here on this, if needed.

 Students coming to the Faculty of Nursing and Occupational Therapy will make sure they send –when requested- the EHIC (European Health Insurance Card) and bring it with them. Also, private insurances can be accepted.

A civil liability insurance for studies in a medical centre is also requested to be sent by email before coming to the UEx (more information will be sent after the nomination deadline from the International Office).

- No language certificate will be required, but it is strongly recommended to have a B1 Spanish level by the time the student arrives here.
